Mission of the Alexian Brothers Alexian Brothers – United States Province The Alexian Brothers are in search of a full-time Vocation Director.

Guided by the powerful motto, "Caritas Christi urget nos" (The love of Christ compels us), the **Alexian Brothers** are a Catholic lay religious order with a centuries-long tradition of compassionate service.

Founded in the early 1300s in Aachen, Germany, the Brothers trace their roots to the Beghards, laymen dedicated to caring for the sick and poor. During the Black Death, they courageously served the afflicted and ensured dignified burials when many turned away. Originally called the "Cellites," they later embraced the name of **St. Alexius**, adopted the **Rule of St. Augustine** in 1469, and were formally recognized by **Pope Sixtus IV in 1472**.

Today, the Alexian Brothers remain faithful to their mission, echoing Christ's words in *Matthew* 25:40:

"Whatever you do for the least of my brothers, you do for me."

In ministries across the United States, the Brothers feed the hungry, care for the sick and dying, support the incarcerated and those returning from prison, and walk with the vulnerable and forgotten.

GENERAL SUMMARY

This full-time position supports vocation ministry with the Alexian Brothers. Key responsibilities include vocation promotion, vocation discernment, maintaining detailed records of inquirers and discerners, managing the application process, and preparing reports on vocation trends. Additionally, the role emphasizes upholding personal and spiritual integrity of the Alexian Brothers by authentically representing the community's values, mission, and charism, while adhering to the standards of the Catholic Church regarding vocation discernment and safeguarding.

PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This role combines accompaniment, vocation discernment, administration, and outreach. Below is a structured outline of the key responsibilities:

Promotion of Vocations

- Develop and implement a strategy for promoting vocations through events, parish visits, media campaigns, and school outreach.
- Represent the community at vocation fairs, youth events, and conferences.
- Maintain and update vocation materials, including brochures, videos, and the community website.
- Stay well-versed in various aspects of social media.

Discernment and Accompaniment

- Respond promptly and pastorally to inquiries about vocations.
- Provide guidance and mentoring for individuals discerning their vocation.
- Facilitate discernment retreats and "come and see" experiences.
- Conduct initial interviews and screenings to assess suitability.

Collaboration and Communication

- Work closely with the leadership team, including the Provincial and the Formation Team.
- Liaise with diocesan vocation offices, campus ministries, and youth groups.
- Participate in networks for vocation directors, such as the National Religious Vocation Conference (NRVC).

Administration and Record-Keeping

- Maintain accurate records of contacts, applicants, and their vocation discernment.

Formation Oversight (Initial Stages)

- The Inquiry Phase lasts 3 to 12 months and is managed by the Vocation Director. This is followed by a 3 to 6 month Pre-Application Phase, during which the Vocation Director, along with the Formation Committee, guides candidates through the aspirancy/postulancy phase until they are accepted into formation.
- Collaborate with the Formation Director to ensure a smooth transition into the postulancy program.

Personal and Spiritual Integrity

- Serve as a visible and authentic witness to the Alexian Brothers' charism, prayer life, and mission.
- Maintain a strong personal prayer life and pursue ongoing formation.
- Uphold the Catholic Church's and Congregation's standards in vocation discernment and safeguarding.

GENERAL

- Participate with the Alexian Brothers formation team to ensure that the mission, vision, and values of the Alexian Brothers are clearly met
- Support the organizational culture of trust, teamwork and competence in service of the members for the overall success of the NRVC.
- Operate as a consistently professional public representative of the Alexian Brothers at all

events.

- Office hours are from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Occasionally, weekend and evening hours may be required. Your flexibility and commitment during these times are greatly appreciated, as they contribute to our collective success.
- Prepare for, attend, assist, and participate in vocation events, with travel expected.
