

## **Vocation Ministry Coordinator**

The Sisters of the Precious Blood are a Roman Catholic congregation of women religious who profess vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, live a common life and engage in lifelong service to others. Since 1834 the Sisters of the Precious Blood have met the needs of the time. Inspired by Maria Anna Brunner, foundress, and her desire "that not one drop of Jesus' Precious Blood be shed in vain," we try to see where the need is great and to respond.
